You may not use any of the following products 2 weeks prior to a peel:

- Alpha Hydroxy Acids
- * Retin A/Renova or any other topical prescriptions
- Oral skin medications
- Benzyl Peroxide
- Decongestants
- Antihistamines
- Depilatory Wax

YOU ARE NOT A CANDIDATE FOR A PEEL IF YOU ARE:

- Pregnant/Nursing
- * Have inflamed skin (Acne/Rosacea)
- * Have open cuts/ lesions on the skin
- Have bacterial or viral diseases of the skin
- Allergic to Milk (Lactic Acid Peel)
- * Allergic to Aspirin (Salicylic Acid Peel)
- * Allergic to Citrus (Citrus C Peel)

POST PEEL INSTRUCTIONS

- Wash facial area gently w/recommended cleanser
- * Keep skin moisturized
- Use Sunscreen with at least 30 SPF

FOR 24 HOURS AVOID:

Sauna's

Steam Rooms

Picking/scratching
